Reminder to all Home Improvers!

The season of renovations, additions, and home improvements is right around the corner. With this in mind, the Planning and Zoning Department wants to make sure you are prepared when you dive head first into your projects this summer.

Whether you are hiring a contractor or tackling your own project it is important to obtain the appropriate permits beforehand. If you are hiring a contractor it is always a good idea to ask your contractor to see the permits prior to commencing work. This is an important item to check and discuss with your contractor because, in the end, it is the homeowner's responsibility to obtain the required permits. Remember applying for a permit does not mean you or your contractor has a permit. If work is started without a permit, even if the permit is applied for, the fees are doubled. Those fees are generally extended to the homeowner. That is why we urge you to plan ahead this summer and obtain all the necessary permits in advance.

Our very popular day camp is back! Our camp seems to get bigger and bigger every year. We will be taking a field trip each week and will be spending more time at each site. Field trips are scheduled for Thursdays and are listed below next to each week. We've added a few new trips and kept some old favorites. We will be swimming again, every Wednesday, at the swim club in Warrington. The facility we use, Bridge Valley Elementary School, is a perfect place for camp! We have air-conditioning to escape the heat, a huge gym with a climbing wall that will be used every week, a large multi-purpose area to do crafts and play ping-pong. Kids will take part in indoor/outdoor games, water games, community building activities, arts and crafts and sports. We will bring in different inflatables every week. Campers should bring something to drink every day, preferably juice or water, NO SODA. Teen Camp

TOWNSHIP UPDATES

by Gail Weniger, Township Manager

WHEN will Route 263 (York Road) be fixed?

Currently scheduled for 2013, PADOT's reconstruction of the York Road corridor is awaiting both funding and right-of-way acquisitions. The project reconstructs the roadway, includes adding shoulders and left turn lanes. It also includes a traffic signal to be installed at Deer Run and York Roads. The traffic signal is a joint project with the Township, the Middle Bucks institute of technology, and the Bucks Club.

The Township has not seen a final plan for this project yet, but has reviewed the stormwater management plans requiring several basins. The Township engineer has worked with PADOT to lessen the impact of the basin locations while preserving the project.

When the final plan is available, it will be on a Board of Supervisor agenda for review. In the meantime, the Township has contacted PADOT regarding the need to do some maintenance on the roadway to get us to 2013. We are awaiting a response.

Where is WAWA?

A frequently asked question is what happened to the WAWA project? The project, which was planned before the down economy, is still on file. An agreement is extended annually to allow the project to be built as planned. Issues, such as bringing public water and sewer to the site, put the project on hold in a down economy. Any changes to the plan would have to be approved by the Board of Supervisors.

When Will the Mill Road Bridge Open?

The Township was notified after the bridge closed that it had failed inspection. The

bridge is owned by the County and was inspected by an engineering firm through PADOT. Currently, the County is working on putting up appropriate signage and evaluating the emergency repairs needed. The Township does not have any additional information on when the bridge will be open again.

When Will Almshouse Road be open again?

The bridge repairs on Almshouse (between Mearns and Rushland) is a PADOT project. It has been relayed to us that the road will be closed until sometime in May.
